SENSATIONS

Very fruity wine, characterized by citrus flavors. Ample and fresh on the palate.



TASTING

Serving temperature: 10° C to 12° C (50° F to 54° F) fish, shellfish, veal During the aperitif, served with shrimps



PAIRING

Served with grilled chop...

| GROUND: Clay-limestone

| SOLAR ORIENTATION: South-East

| GRAPE VARIETY: 100 % Aligoté Only "appellation Village" grape variety

| VINE'S AGE: 25 years

| YIELD: 60 hl/ha

| PRODUCTION: +/- 4 000 bottles

| VINIFICATION/AGING: Hand-picked harvesting. After a soft pressing, musts ferment partly in oak barrels (25%) and in stainless steel vats (75%) for 8 months.

| RECOMMENDED STORAGE TIME: 2 to 5 years (a decanting time is required before serving)

| STORAGE TEMPERATURE: 10° C to 14° C (50° F to 57° F)
